# Golf Tournament Planning & Guidelines

## All Tournament Packages Also Include:

- Two certificates for complimentary rounds of golf for your prize table.
- Starting sheets for the assignment of your golfer's "tee times" or holes to commence "shot-gun" play.
- Assistance with the placement of any hole-sponsor signs and banners.
- Prize-hole markers for longest-drive, closest-to-the-pin and similar competitions.
- Props for putting contests on our practice green.
- Great sound system for announcements and awarding of prizes

## Tournament Guidelines:

### Please share these guidelines with participants.

- A \$300 Deposit is required to secure a date & time for your group.
- A large fleet of **Power Carts** is available and organizers are encouraged to make carts a part of the tournament package. The proper care and caution must be taken by all golfers using power carts. Golf course staff can provide assistance and instruction to golfers re: the use of power carts.
- Appropriate **Golf Attire** for all golfers is required at Chippewa Creek Golf Club.
- **Golfers Should Arrive 45 minutes prior to a shotgun start and at least 20 minutes prior to a tee time start.**
- Golfers should be able to follow the **Pace of Play** - to play 9 holes in 2 hours and 15 minutes and 18 holes in 4 hours and 30 minutes. On course Rangers can provide assistance to golfers in order to maintain proper pace of play.
- Please show **On Course Consideration** for your fellow golfer by repairing ball-marks on the greens, replacing divots and raking sand traps.
- **Adverse Weather** will be signaled by staff and staff will indicate when it is safe to resume play. Golf play may proceed in less than ideal conditions and meals are rain or

shine events.

- **The Liquor Control Board of Ontario requires that all alcoholic beverages consumed on the property must be purchased from Chippewa Creek Golf Club.** *Golfers are prohibited from bringing their own alcohol onto the golf course property.
